GET STARTED

•Christmas Shoebox is a gift built by you and sent by Team Hope. Here's what you/need to do to build your box at home or online.



- Wrap a regular shoebox in colourful paper
- Choose if your box is for a boy or a girl and the age group. Place the sticker on the top right corner of your wrapped box
- Fill your box with items from EACH of the 4 W's (examples below)
- Donate your €5.00* online at www.teamhope.ie or use the envelope in this leaflet
- Close your box with an elastic band (please don't seal)
- Drop your box into a drop off point (full list online)

Don't forget to include €5















- No time to shop? You can still send a gift! You can build your box or boxes online at www.teamhope.ie
- For every €25** our in-country partners will prepare your Christmas Shoebox
- You have the option to use the fun box builder to select your 4 W's!
- Together with our partners we ensure these gifts are suitable and culturally appropriate

*The €5 donation goes towards the cost of making the whole project happen, including promotion, transport and delivering of your box to each child.**Donations of €25 per online box cover these costs as well as the purchase of shoebox contents based on the 4W's. If there are any surplus funds, they are used for on-going development work with children, their families and communities. If your shoebox is very large we may (reluctantly) have to divide it.

- Gloves





How to get your Christmas Shoebox to us?

If you have less than 50 boxes:

- Check our website www.teamhope.ie at the end of October for a list of all our drop off points or phone 01 2940222
- Drop your boxes BEFORE 10th November
- If your school is involved bring your shoeboxes into school when requested

If you have more than 50 boxes:

- Please contact us and we will connect you with a local Team Hope volunteer. They will then do their best to collect your shoeboxes on an agreed date.
- Cut out your label.
- Tick the relevant age box.
- Glue the back of the label and stick to the top right hand corner of your box (using tape if necessary).
