Team Hope is best known for the Team Hope <u>Christmas Shoebox Appeal</u>, an annual campaign where thousands of individuals in Ireland donate shoeboxes filled with gifts to be given to children affected by poverty. Each year we encourage businesses big and small; their staff families and friends, to #MakeAChildSmile by creating shoebox gifts, either physically or online.

Running an in-house Christmas Shoebox Appeal Workshop

Gathering your team to build Christmas Shoeboxes is a great way to offer team bonding as well as making a real difference!

You will need:

- 1. A Team Hope Christmas Shoebox Appeal leaflet per employee
- Shoeboxes. You can use any shoeboxes you like provided they aren't too big or too small. You can purchase Team Hope Shoeboxes in bundles of 50 for €95 directly from Team Hope.
- 3. Items to fill your Christmas Shoeboxes with (as below)
- Wrapping paper
- 5. A €5 donation per box (this can be added to each box or made online).



How to Build a Christmas Shoebox


- 1. Cover a regular sized shoebox in colourful paper.
- 2. Use the label from your <u>leaflet</u> to decide if your box is for a boy or a girl and the age group.
- 3. Insert items from the "4 W's" completely filling your box. (Wash, Write, Wear and WOW!).
- 4. Include your €5 donation* in your Team Hope envelope or donate <u>online</u> at <u>www.teamhope.ie/donate</u> and close your box with just an elastic band
- 5. Leave your box at one of our 400+ drop-off points



How to Build a Christmas Shoebox Online

Every €25 donated will enable Team Hope's overseas partners to create a Christmas Shoebox and deliver out into the hands of a child affected by poverty.

Apply to help at one of our Shoebox checking centres around the country

Our Christmas Shoebox Appeal uses 50+ volunteer run centres, nationwide to collect, check, package and load Christmas Shoeboxes onto trucks, headed for their new homes. Over 2,500 volunteers to help us annually in October and November to collect shoeboxes from our various drop off points, businesses and schools, to check the contents of the donated shoebox gifts, to pack them into cartons and to load them onto trucks sending them to their final destinations in countries in Eastern Europe and Africa.

From 1-100 hours, you can volunteer your time to get together in a fun environment to help in your local checking centre.

Our corporate volunteer hours fill up fast so get in touch early if you'd like to get your team involved

Where do your Christmas Shoeboxes go?

Team Hope sends Christmas Shoeboxes to our local partners in 12+ countries annually, who work in areas affected by poverty. This year, Team Hope aims to send Shoebox gifts to children in Romania, Transnistria (Moldova), Ukraine, Albania, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Lesotho, Eswatini, Malawi, Kenya and Rwanda. Team Hope will continue to send shoeboxes to Ukraine to children affected by the ongoing war, as long as it remains logistically possible.



Team Hope's Overseas Partners

Team Hope works with locally based partners in all our international project and programme countries across Eastern Europe and Sub-Saharan Africa. Our partners are engaged in tackling poverty in their communities and are well placed to reach those on the very margins of society.

Team Hope's Year Round Work

Team Hope's strategic goals are aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals, focusing on No Poverty, Zero Hunger and Clean Water and to that end we deliver life changing sustainable development initiatives. By working with partner communities overseas, we are building strong, safe and progressive environments for vulnerable children and establishing real change for a brighter future. Since 2010 Team Hope has supported at least 150 sustainable development projects in 20 countries across Africa and Eastern Europe. We work closely with our local partners who provide a direct link to the communities we operate in.
