## Lollipop Me!

T-shirt totes make use of things students have at home. They are easy to make, even for little fingers and so useful for their recipients. Plus they practice scissor skills and fine motor skills.

1. Cut off sleeves & neckline
2. Cut ends approx. 1 inch apart and 3 inches deep
3. Double knot the ends
4. Turn right side out again!
